A BILL

To delay the effective date of certain provisions relating
to the labeling of ginseng.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “Ginseng Labeling Cor-
3 rection Act”.

**4 SEC. 2. DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE REGARDING GINSENG
5 LABELING.**

6 Section 403(u) of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cos-
7 metic Act (21 U.S.C. 343(u); 116 Stat. 526), and section
8 10806(b)(1) of the Farm Security and Rural Investment
9 Act of 2002 (21 U.S.C. 321d; 116 Stat. 526), are each
10 deemed to have first become effective 30 days after the
11 date of the enactment of this Act.
