AN ACT

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for the appointment of chiropractors in the Veterans Health Administration of the Department of Veterans Affairs and to provide eligibility for Department of Veterans Affairs health care for certain Filipino World War II veterans residing in the United States.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Health Care
5	Improvement Act of 2003".
6	SEC. 2. APPOINTMENT OF CHIROPRACTORS IN THE VET-
7	ERANS HEALTH ADMINISTRATION.
8	(a) APPOINTMENTS.—Section 7401 of title 38,
9	United States Code, is amended—
10	(1) by inserting "and chiropractic care" in the
11	matter preceding paragraph (1) after "medical
12	care"; and
13	(2) by inserting "chiropractors," in paragraph
14	(1) after "podiatrists,".
15	(b) QUALIFICATIONS OF APPOINTEES.—Section
16	7402(b) of such title is amended—
17	(1) by redesignating paragraph (10) as para-
18	graph (11) ; and
19	(2) by inserting after paragraph (9) the fol-
20	lowing new paragraph (10):
21	"(10) CHIROPRACTOR.—To be eligible to be ap-
22	pointed to a chiropractor position, a person must—
23	"(A) hold the degree of doctor of chiropractic,
24	or its equivalent, from a college of chiropractic ap-

"(B) be licensed to practice chiropractic in a 1 2 State.". 3 (c) PERIOD OF APPOINTMENTS AND PROMOTIONS.— 4 Section 7403(a)(2) of such title is amended by adding at 5 the end the following new subparagraph: 6 "(H) Chiropractors.". 7 (d) GRADES AND PAY SCALES.—Section 7404(b)(1) 8 of such title is amended by striking the third center head-9 ing in the table and inserting the following: "CLINICAL PODIATRIST, CHIROPRACTOR, AND OPTOMETRIST SCHEDULE". 10 (e) TEMPORARY AND PART-TIME APPOINTMENTS.— 11 Section 7405(a) of such title is amended— 12 (1) by adding at the end of paragraph (1) the 13 following new subparagraph: 14 "(E) Chiropractors."; and 15 (2) by adding at the end of paragraph (2) the 16 following new subparagraph: "(D) Chiropractors.". 17 18 (f) RESIDENCIES AND INTERNSHIPS.—Section 19 7406(c) of such title is amended— 20 (1) in paragraph (1)— (A) by inserting "and chiropractic" after 21 22 "medical" the first place it appears; and (B) by inserting "or chiropractic" after 23 "medical" the second place it appears: 24

1	(2) in paragraph $(2)(B)$, by inserting "or chiro-
2	practic" after "medical" the first place it appears;
3	and
4	(3) in paragraph (3)(A), by inserting "or chiro-
5	practic" after "medical".
6	(g) MALPRACTICE AND NEGLIGENCE PROTECTION.—
7	Section 7316(a) of such title is amended—
8	(1) in paragraph (1) , by inserting "or chiro-
9	practic" after "medical" each place it appears; and
10	(2) in paragraph (2) —
11	(A) by inserting "or chiropractic" after
12	"medical" the first place it appears; and
13	(B) by inserting "chiropractor," after "po-
14	diatrist,".
15	(h) TREATMENT AS SCARCE MEDICAL SPECIALISTS
16	FOR CONTRACTING PURPOSES.—Section 7409(a) of such
17	title is amended by inserting "chiropractors," in the sec-
18	ond sentence after "optometrists,".
19	(i) Reimbursement of Continuing Profes-
20	SIONAL EDUCATION EXPENSES.—Section 7411 of such
21	title is amended by striking "or dentist" and inserting ",
22	dentist, or chiropractic".
23	(j) Collective Bargaining Exemption.—Section
24	7421(b) of such title is amended by adding at the end
25	the following new paragraph:

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"(8) Chiropractors.".

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2 (k) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
3 this section shall take effect at the end of the 180–day
4 period beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act.
5 SEC. 3. ELIGIBILITY FOR DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF6 FAIRS HEALTH CARE OF CERTAIN FILIPINO
7 WORLD WAR II VETERANS RESIDING IN THE
8 UNITED STATES.

(a) ELIGIBILITY.—The text of section 1734 of title 9 10 38, United States Code, is amended to read as follows: 11 "(a) The Secretary shall furnish hospital and nursing 12 home care and medical services to any individual described 13 in subsection (b) in the same manner, and subject to the same terms and conditions, as apply to the furnishing of 14 15 such care and services to individuals who are veterans as defined in section 101(2) of this title. Any disability of 16 17 an individual described in subsection (b) that is a serviceconnected disability for purposes of this subchapter (as 18 provided for under section 1735(2) of this title) shall be 19 20 considered to be a service-connected disability for purposes 21 of furnishing care and services under the preceding sen-22 tence.

23 "(b) Subsection (a) applies to any individual who is
24 a Commonwealth Army veteran or new Philippine Scout
25 and who—

"(1) is residing in the United States; and

2 "(2) is a citizen of the United States or an
3 alien lawfully admitted to the United States for per4 manent residence.".

5 (b) LIMITATION.—(1) The amendment made by sub-6 section (a) shall take effect on the date on which the Sec-7 retary of Veterans Affairs submits to the Committees on 8 Veterans' Affairs of the Senate and House of Representa-9 tives and publishes in the Federal Register a certification 10 described in paragraph (2).

(2) A certification referred to in paragraph (1) is a
certification that sufficient resources are available for the
fiscal year during which the certification is submitted to
carry out section 1734 of title 38, United States Code,
as amended by such amendment, during that fiscal year
at each significantly affected health care facility of the Department of Veterans Affairs.

18 (3) For purposes of paragraph (2), the term "significantly affected health care facility" means a health care 19 20facility at which, as determined by the Secretary, it is rea-21 sonably foreseeable that the implementation of the provi-22 sions of section 1734 of title 38, United States Code, as 23 amended by subsection (a), will result in a significant in-24 crease in the use of health care resources due to the num-25 ber of veterans described in subsection (b) of that section

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1 who are considered to be likely to seek hospital or nursing

 $2 \hspace{0.1in} \text{home care or medical services, as authorized by subsection}$

3 (a) of that section, at that facility.
