## A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to provide an exemption from Interstate System weight limitations for milk hauling vehicles in the State of Connecticut.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FROM INTERSTATE SYSTEM**  
4 **WEIGHT LIMITATIONS FOR MILK HAULING**  
5 **VEHICLES IN CONNECTICUT.**

6 Section 127(a) of title 23, United States Code, is  
7 amended by adding at the end the following: “The State  
8 of Connecticut may allow, by special permit, on Interstate

- 1 System highways in the State the operation of vehicles
- 2 with a gross vehicle weight of up to 99,000 pounds for
- 3 the hauling of milk in liquid form.”.
