- 9 of long-term leases", approved August 9, 1955 (25 U.S.C.
- 10 415(a)) is amended by inserting "lands held in trust for

- 1 the Yurok Tribe, lands held in trust for the Hopland Band
- 2 of Pomo Indians of the Hopland Rancheria," after "Pueb-
- 3 lo of Santa Clara,".
- 4 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 5 subsection (a) shall apply to any lease entered into or re-
- 6 newed after the date of the enactment of this Act.
