A BILL

For the relief of Zdenko Lisak.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL OF, OR
4 DENIAL OF ADMISSION TO, ZDENKO LISAK.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections 212(a)
6 and 237(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act,
7 Zdenko Lisak may not be removed from the United States,
8 or denied admission to the United States, by reason of
9 any act of his that is a ground for removal or denial of
10 admission and is reflected in the records of the Immigra-
11 tion and Naturalization Service of the Department of Jus-

1 tice, or the Visa Office of the Department of State, on
2 the date of the enactment of this Act.

3 (b) RESCISSION OF OUTSTANDING ORDER OF RE-
4 MOVAL.—The Attorney General shall rescind any out-
5 standing order of removal or deportation, or any finding
6 of deportability, that has been entered against Zdenko
7 Lisak by reason of any act described in subsection (a).
