#### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Insular Areas Commu-

5 nity Development Act".

## 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DE-7 VELOPMENT ACT OF 1974.

8 Section 108 of the Housing and Community Develop-

9 ment Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5308) is amended—

(1) in the fourth sentence of subsection (a), by
inserting "on the basis that the eligible public entity
is eligible for grants under this title only pursuant
to section 107(b)(1) or" after "section"; and

5 (2) in subsection (o), by adding after the period 6 at the end the following new sentence: "Such term 7 includes Guam. the Virgin Islands, American 8 Samoa, and the Commonwealth of the Northern 9 Mariana Islands, and general purpose political sub-10 divisions thereof.".

#### 11 SEC. 3. REGULATIONS.

12 Not later than the expiration of the 120-day period 13 beginning upon the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development shall issue 14 15 and implement regulations to carry out the amendments made by this Act and to provide for the guarantee, under 16 17 section 108 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (42 U.S.C. 5308), of notes or other obliga-18 tions issued by eligible public entities specified in the sec-19 20 ond sentence of subsection (o) of such section 108 (as 21 added by the amendment made by section 2(2) of this 22 Act).
