A BILL

To redesignate the Federal building located at 935 Pennsylvania Avenue Northwest in the District of Columbia as the “Federal Bureau of Investigation Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION.**

4 The Federal building located at 935 Pennsylvania
5 Avenue Northwest in the District of Columbia, commonly
6 known as the J. Edgar Hoover Federal Building, shall be

1 known and designated as the “Federal Bureau of Inves-
2 tigation Building”.

3 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

4 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
5 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
6 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
7 a reference to the “Federal Bureau of Investigation Build-
8 ing”.
