A BILL

To amend the Water Resources Development Act of 1976 to allow the Secretary of the Army to extend the period during which the Secretary may provide beach nourishment for a water resources development project.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. BEACH NOURISHMENT.**

4 Section 156 of the Water Resources Development Act
5 of 1976 (1962d–5f) is amended

6 (1) by inserting “(a) IN GENERAL.—” before
7 “The Secretary”; and

8 (2) by adding at the end the following:

1 “(b) REQUESTS FOR EXTENSIONS.—At the request
2 of a non-Federal interest, the Secretary, acting through
3 the Chief of Engineers, may extend the period during
4 which the Secretary provides beach nourishment for a
5 project under subsection (a) for such additional period as
6 the Secretary determines necessary, except that the addi-
7 tional period may not exceed 50 years. ”.
