A BILL

To amend section 2119 of title 18, United States Code,
to strengthen Federal carjacking law.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT RELATING TO SECTION 2119 OF**

4 **TITLE 18, UNITED STATES CODE.**

5 Section 2119 is amended—

6 (1) by striking “, with the intent to cause death
7 or serious bodily harm”;

8 (2) at the end of paragraph (1)—

9 (A) by striking the comma; and

10 (B) by inserting a semi-colon;

1 (3) at the end of paragraph (2)—

2 (A) by striking “, and”; and

3 (B) by inserting a semi-colon;

4 (4) at the end of paragraph (3)—

5 (A) by striking “, or sentenced to death.”;

6 and

7 (B) by inserting “; or”; and

8 (5) by adding at the end the following new
9 paragraph:

10 “(4) if death results and such act was com-
11 mitted with the intent to cause death or serious bod-
12 ily harm, be fined under this title or imprisoned for
13 any number of years up to life, or both, or sentenced
14 to death.”.
