- 5 (a) STUDY.—The Comptroller General shall conduct6 a study on—
- 7 (1) the impact of price controls of foreign gov-8 ernments on pharmaceuticals, including the impact

of such price controls on full market access for
 United States pharmaceuticals and on increased
 prices for pharmaceuticals generally for United
 States consumers; and

5 (2) the extent to which negotiations conducted
6 by the United States Trade Representative under
7 the Bipartisan Trade Promotion Authority Act of
8 2002 (title XXI of division B of the Trade Act of
9 2002) facilitate the elimination of such price con10 trols of foreign governments on pharmaceuticals.

(b) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
of the enactment of this Act, and every 5 years thereafter,
the Comptroller General shall prepare and submit to Congress a report that contains the results of the study conducted under subsection (a) for the preceding 1- or 5-year
period (as the case may be).

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
