A BILL

To direct the President to assess the advisability of requiring each State to use the Death Master File of the Social Security Administration in issuing drivers' licenses to individuals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the "Secure Identity Protec-
5 tion Act".

1 **SEC. 2. USE OF MASTER DEATH FILE IN ISSUANCE OF DRIV-**
2 **ERS' LICENSES.**

3 (a) **STUDY.**—The President shall conduct a study to
4 assess the advisability of requiring each State to use the
5 Death Master File of the Social Security Administration
6 in issuing drivers' licenses to individuals as a method of
7 determining the validity of the social security numbers
8 supplied by the individuals.

9 (b) **REPORT.**—Not later than 180 days after the date
10 of enactment of this Act, the President shall transmit to
11 Congress a report on the results of the study.

12 (c) **DELEGATION.**—The President shall conduct the
13 study acting through the head of an appropriate Federal
14 department or agency, as designated by the President.
