Mr. TOOMEY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Gracekuty Thomas and her son Gladwin
Thomas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act, (8 U.S.C.
6 1101 et seq.), Ms. Gracekuty Thomas and her son
7 Gladwin Thomas shall be held and considered to have been
8 lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent resi-
9 dence as of the date of the enactment of this Act upon
10 payment of the required visa fees.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

2 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Ms.
3 Gracekutty Thomas and her son Gladwin Thomas, as pro-
4 vided in this Act, the Secretary of State shall instruct the
5 proper officer to reduce by the appropriate number during
6 the current fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas
7 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth
8 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
9 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
