A BILL

To amend title 36, United States Code, to grant a Federal charter to the Sons and Daughters of Pearl Harbor Survivors, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Sons and Daughters
- 5 of Pearl Harbor Survivors Charter Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. CHARTER FOR SONS AND DAUGHTERS OF PEARL
- 7 HARBOR SURVIVORS.
- 8 (a) In General.—Part B of subtitle II of title 36,
- 9 United States Code, is amended by inserting after chapter
- 10 1703 the following new chapter:

1 "CHAPTER 1704—SONS AND DAUGHTERS

2 OF PEARL HARBOR SURVIVORS

- "170401. Organization.
- "170402. Purposes.
- "170403. Membership.
- "170404. Governing body.
- "170405. Powers.
- "170406. Exclusive Right to Name, Seals, Emblems, and Badges.
- "170407. Restrictions.
- "170408. Duty to Maintain Corporate and Tax-Exempt Status.
- "170409. Records and Inspection.
- "170410. Service of Process.
- "170411. Liability for acts of officers and agents.
- "170412. Annual report.
- "170413. Definitions.

3 **"§ 170401. Organization**

- 4 "(a) Federal Charter.—The Sons and Daughters
- 5 of Pearl Harbor Survivors, a nonprofit corporation orga-
- 6 nized under the laws of the State of Florida, is a federally
- 7 chartered corporation.
- 8 "(b) Expiration of Charter.—If the corporation
- 9 does not comply with any provision of this chapter, the
- 10 charter granted by subsection (a) expires.

11 **"§ 170402. Purposes**

- 12 "The purposes of the corporation are fraternal, patri-
- 13 otic, historical, and educational as provided in its bylaws
- 14 and articles of incorporation and shall include the fol-
- 15 lowing:
- 16 "(1) To preserve, teach, and promote true pa-
- 17 triotism and loyalty to the United States of America.

- 1 "(2) To perpetuate the memory of the service-2 men and servicewomen and the events pertaining to 3 that Day of Infamy, 7 December 1941.
- "(3) To assist in the preservation and encourage the study of documents and chronicles of service performed by the Pearl Harbor survivors and nonsurvivors.
- 8 "(4) To celebrate the anniversary of the bomb-9 ing of Pearl Harbor, the island of Oahu, on 7 De-10 cember 1941.
- 11 "(5) To unite and promote comradeship among 12 descendants.
- 13 "(6) To encourage in all people an under-14 standing of 7 December 1941, which will guard 15 against future attacks on American soil.

16 **"§ 170403. Membership**

- 17 "Eligibility for membership in the corporation, and
- 18 the rights and privileges of the members of the corpora-
- 19 tion, are as provided in the bylaws of the corporation.

20 **"§ 170404. Governing body**

- 21 "(a) Board of Directors.—The board of directors
- 22 of the corporation and the responsibilities of the board are
- 23 as provided in the bylaws and articles of incorporation of
- 24 the corporation.

- 1 "(b) Officers.—The officers and the election of offi-
- 2 cers of the corporation are as provided in the bylaws and
- 3 articles of incorporation of the corporation.

4 "§ 170405. Powers

- 5 "The corporation has only the powers provided in its
- 6 bylaws and articles of incorporation filed in each State in
- 7 which it is incorporated.
- 8 "§ 170406. Exclusive right to name, seals, emblems,
- 9 and badges
- 10 "The corporation shall have the exclusive right to use
- 11 the name 'Sons and Daughters of Pearl Harbor Survivors'
- 12 and any seals, emblems, and badges the corporation
- 13 adopts.

14 **"§ 170407. Restrictions**

- 15 "(a) Stock and Dividends.—The corporation may
- 16 not issue stock or declare or pay a dividend.
- 17 "(b) Political Activities.—The corporation, or
- 18 any director or officer of the corporation, acting as such
- 19 director or officer, may not contribute to, support, or oth-
- 20 erwise participate in any political activity or in any man-
- 21 ner attempt to influence legislation.
- 22 "(c) Distribution of Income or Assets.—No
- 23 part of the income or assets of the corporation may inure
- 24 to the benefit of, or be distributed to, any director, officer,
- 25 or employee of the corporation during the life of the char-

- 1 ter granted by this chapter. Nothing in this subsection
- 2 may be construed to prevent the payment of reasonable
- 3 compensation to the officers and employees of the corpora-
- 4 tion or the reimbursement of actual necessary expenses
- 5 in the amounts approved by the board of directors of the
- 6 corporation.
- 7 "(d) Loan.—The corporation may not make a loan
- 8 to any director, officer, or employee of the corporation.
- 9 "(e) Claim of Government Approval or Au-
- 10 THORITY.—The corporation may not claim the approval
- 11 of Congress or the authorization of the United States Gov-
- 12 ernment for any of its activities.
- 13 "§ 170408. Duty to maintain corporate and tax-ex-
- 14 empt status
- 15 "(a) Corporate Status.—The corporation shall
- 16 maintain its status as a corporation incorporated under
- 17 the laws of the State of Florida.
- 18 "(b) Tax-Exempt Status.—The corporation shall
- 19 maintain its status as an organization exempt from tax-
- 20 ation under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
- 21 "§ 170409. Records and inspection
- 22 "(a) Records.—The corporation shall keep—
- 23 "(1) correct and complete records of account;

- 1 "(2) minutes of the proceedings of its members,
- 2 board of directors, and committees having any of the
- authority of its board of directors; and
- 4 "(3) at its principal office, a record of the
- 5 names and addresses of its members entitled to vote,
- 6 if any.
- 7 "(b) Inspection.—A member entitled to vote on
- 8 matters relating to the corporation, or an agent or attor-
- 9 new of the member, may inspect the records of the cor-
- 10 poration for any proper purpose, at any reasonable time.

11 "§ 170410. Service of process

- 12 "The corporation shall comply with the law on service
- 13 of process of the State of Florida and in each State in
- 14 which it carries on activities.

15 "§ 170411. Liability for acts of officers and agents

- 16 "The corporation is liable for the acts of its officers
- 17 and agents acting within the scope of their authority.

18 **"§ 170412. Annual report**

- 19 "The corporation shall submit to Congress an annual
- 20 report on the activities of the corporation during the pre-
- 21 ceding fiscal year. The report shall be submitted at the
- 22 same time as the report of the audit required by section
- 23 10101 of this title. The report may not be printed as a
- 24 public document.

1 **"§ 170413. Definitions**

- 2 "For the purposes of this chapter:
- 3 "(1) The term 'corporation' means the Sons
- 4 and Daughters of Pearl Harbor Survivors.
- 5 "(2) The term 'State' includes the District of
- 6 Columbia and the territories and possessions of the
- 7 United States.".
- 8 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of chapters
- 9 at the beginning of subtitle II of title 36, United States
- 10 Code, is amended by inserting after the item relating to
- 11 chapter 1703 the following new item:
