A BILL

To reauthorize the Emergency Steel Loan Guarantee Act of 1999, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF GUARANTEE AUTHORITY.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 101(k) of the Emergency
5 Steel Loan Guarantee Act of 1999 (Public Law 106–51;
6 15 U.S.C. 1841 note) is amended by striking “2003” and
7 inserting “2005”.

8 (b) SALARIES AND EXPENSES.—In addition to funds
9 made available under section 101(j) of the Emergency

1 Steel Loan Guarantee Act of 1999 (15 U.S.C. 1841 note),
2 up to \$2,000,000 in funds made available under section
3 101(f) of such Act may be used for salaries and adminis-
4 trative expenses to administer the Emergency Steel Loan
5 Guarantee Program.
