A BILL

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Keep America Secure5 Act".

1SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST PURCHASING EQUIPMENT2CONTAINING ELECTRONIC COMPONENTS3NOT MANUFACTURED IN THE UNITED4STATES.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense and the
6 Secretary of Homeland Security may not purchase any
7 equipment that contains electronic components that are
8 not manufactured in the United States.

9 (b) EXCEPTION.—The Secretary concerned may 10 waive the application of subsection (a) with respect to a 11 purchase if the Secretary determines that application of 12 such subsection to such purchase would be inconsistent 13 with the public interest or would result in unreasonable 14 costs to the Department of Defense or the Department 15 of Homeland Security, as the case may be.

(c) DEFINITION.—For purposes of this Act, the term
"electronic components" includes, but is not limited to—

18 (1) any integrated chip or sensing device;

19 (2) communications systems and equipment;

20 (3) search, navigation, and guidance systems21 and equipment; and

(4) software associated with the items describedin paragraphs (1) through (3).
