To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide permanent authority for the exemption for certain members of the uniformed services from an otherwise-applicable requirement for the payment of subsistence charges while hospitalized.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-1 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT AUTHORITY FOR EXEMPTION FOR 4 CERTAIN MEMBERS OF THE UNIFORMED SERVICES FROM REQUIREMENT TO PAY SUB-6 SISTENCE CHARGES WHILE HOSPITALIZED. 7 Subsection (c) of section 1075 of title 10, United States Code (as added by section 8146(a)(2) of the De-8 partment of Defense Appropriations Act, 2004 (Public 10 Law 108–87)), is repealed. Passed the House of Representatives October 8, 2003.
