Mr. ACEVEDO-VILÁ introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To authorize a major medical facility project at the San Juan, Puerto Rico, Department of Veterans Affairs medical center.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF MAJOR MEDICAL FACILITY
4 PROJECT, SAN JUAN, PUERTO RICO.

5 The Secretary of Veterans Affairs may carry out a
6 major medical facility project at the Department of Vet-
7 erns Affairs medical center in San Juan, Puerto Rico,
8 to make improvements, in an amount not to exceed
9 \$30,000,000, in order to bring that facility into compli-

1 ance with the Department of Veterans Affairs directive
2 designated as the CD-54 Natural Disasters Directive.

3 **SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—There is authorized to be appro-
5 priated to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs for fiscal year
6 2004 for the Construction, Major Projects, account
7 \$30,000,000 for the project authorized in section 1.

8 (b) LIMITATION.—The project authorized in section
9 1 may only be carried out using—

10 (1) funds appropriated for fiscal year 2004 pur-
11 suant to the authorization of appropriations in sub-
12 section (a);

13 (2) funds appropriated for Construction, Major
14 Projects, for a fiscal year before fiscal year 2004
15 that remain available for obligation; and

16 (3) funds appropriated for Construction, Major
17 Projects, for fiscal year 2004 for a category of activ-
18 ity not specific to a project.
