A BILL

To provide a 10 percent increase in the rate of basic pay for members of the uniformed services, effective January 1, 2004, to pay a one-time bonus to members of the Armed Forces who served or serve in a combat zone designated for Operation Iraqi Freedom or Operation Enduring Freedom, and for other purposes.

1 **SECTION 1. INCREASE IN BASIC PAY FOR FISCAL YEAR**
2 **2004.**

3 (a) **WAIVER OF SECTION 1009 ADJUSTMENT.**—The
4 adjustment to become effective during fiscal year 2004 re-
5 quired by section 1009 of title 37, United States Code,
6 in the rates of monthly basic pay authorized members of
7 the uniformed services shall not be made.

8 (b) **INCREASE IN BASIC PAY.**—Effective on January
9 1, 2004, the rates of monthly basic pay for members of
10 the uniformed services are increased by 10 percent.

11 **SEC. 2. ONE-TIME BONUS FOR SERVICE IN COMBAT ZONE**
12 **DESIGNATED FOR OPERATION IRAQI FREE-**
13 **DOM OR OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM.**

14 (a) **MILITARY SERVICES.**—The Secretary of Defense
15 shall pay a one-time bonus of \$1,500 to each member of
16 the Army, Navy, Air Force, or Marine Corps, including
17 reserve components thereof, who served or serves for any
18 period of time in a combat zone designated in connection
19 with Operation Iraqi Freedom or Operation Enduring
20 Freedom.

21 (b) **COAST GUARD.**—The Secretary of Homeland Se-
22 curity shall pay a one-time bonus of \$1,500 to each mem-
23 ber of the Coast Guard or Coast Guard Reserve who
24 served or serves for any period of time in a combat zone

- 1 designated in connection with Operation Iraqi Freedom or
- 2 Operation Enduring Freedom.
