A BILL

To correct and improve the prohibition against terrorism transcending national boundaries, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Terrorism Tran-
5 scending National Boundaries Correction Act of 2003”.

6 **SEC. 2. TECHNICAL CORRECTION RELATING TO DEFINI-**
7 **TION USED IN “TERRORISM TRANSCENDING**
8 **NATIONAL BOUNDARIES” STATUTE.**

9 Section 1958 of title 18, United States Code, is
10 amended—

1 (1) in subsection (a), by striking “facility in”
2 and inserting “facility of”; and

3 (2) in subsection (b)(2), by inserting “or for-
4 eign” after “interstate”.
