AN ACT

- To amend the Mineral Leasing Act to authorize the Secretary of the Interior to issue separately, for the same area, a lease for tar sand and a lease for oil and gas, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. COMBINED HYDROCARBON LEASING.

- 2 (a) Special Provisions Regarding Leasing.—
- 3 Section 17(b)(2) of the Mineral Leasing Act (30 U.S.C.
- 4 226(b)(2) is amended—
- 5 (1) by inserting "(A)" after "(2)"; and
- 6 (2) by adding at the end the following:
- 7 "(B) The Secretary may issue under this Act for the
- 8 same area, separately—
- 9 "(i) a lease for exploration for and extraction of
- tar sand; and
- "(ii) a lease for exploration for and development
- of oil and gas.
- 13 "(C) A lease issued under subparagraph (B)(ii) shall
- 14 not be further subject to the Combined Hydrocarbon Leas-
- 15 ing Act of 1981 (30 U.S.C. 181 et seq.).
- 16 "(D) A lease issued for tar sand shall be issued using
- 17 the same bidding process, annual rental, and posting pe-
- 18 riod as a lease issued for oil and gas, except that the min-
- 19 imum acceptable bid required for a lease issued for tar
- 20 sand shall be \$2 per acre.
- 21 "(E) The Secretary may waive, suspend, or alter any
- 22 requirement under section 26 that a permittee under a
- 23 permit authorizing prospecting for tar sand must exercise
- 24 due diligence, to promote any resource covered by a com-
- 25 bined hydrocarbon lease.".

- 1 (b) Conforming Amendment.—Section
- 2 17(b)(1)(B) of the Mineral Leasing Act (30 U.S.C.
- 3 226(b)(1)(B)) is amended in the second sentence by in-
- 4 serting ", subject to paragraph (2)(B)," after "the Sec-
- 5 retary".
- 6 SEC. 2. REGULATIONS.
- 7 Within 45 days after the date of the enactment of
- 8 this Act, the Secretary of the Interior shall issue final reg-
- 9 ulations to implement this Act.
