A BILL

To amend the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund of 2001 to extend the deadline for filing a claim to December 31, 2004.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “September 11th Victim

5 Compensation Fund Extension Act of 2003”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE TO FILE A CLAIM TO DE-**2 **CEMBER 31, 2004.**

3 Section 405(a) of September 11th Victim Compensation Fund of 2001 (Public Law 107-42; 49 U.S.C. 40101 note) is amended by striking paragraph (3) and inserting

6 the following:

7 “(3) LIMITATION.—No claim may be filed
8 under paragraph (1) after December 31, 2004.”.
