3 SECTION 1. HEAD START ACT AMENDMENT IMPOSING PA-

4 RENTAL CONSENT REQUIREMENT FOR NON-

5 EMERGENCY INTRUSIVE PHYSICAL EXAMINA6 TIONS.

7 The Head Start Act (42 U.S.C. 9831 et seq.) is8 amended by adding at the end the following new section:

Mr. SULLIVAN (for himself, Mr. PITTS, Mr. DEMINT, Mrs. MUSGRAVE, and Mr. BURGESS) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and the Workforce

"SEC. 657A. PARENTAL CONSENT REQUIREMENT FOR NON EMERGENCY INTRUSIVE PHYSICAL EXAMINA TIONS.

4 "(a) IN GENERAL.—A Head Start agency shall ob5 tain written parental consent before administration of any
6 nonemergency intrusive physical examination of a child in
7 connection with participation in a program under this sub8 chapter.

9 "(b) DEFINITION.—The term 'nonemergency intru10 sive physical examination' means, with respect to a child,
11 a physical examination that—

12 "(1) is not immediately necessary to protect the
13 health or safety of the child involved or the health
14 or safety of another individual; and

15 "(2) requires incision or is otherwise invasive,
16 or involves exposure of private body parts".
