## AN ACT

To provide for the designation of a Department of Agriculture disaster liaison to assist State and local employees of the Department in coordination with other disaster agencies in response to a federally declared disaster area as a result of a disaster.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	$tives\ of\ the\ United\ States\ of\ America\ in\ Congress\ assembled,$
3	SECTION 1. LIAISON FOR DISASTER EMERGENCIES.
4	(a) Deployment of Disaster Liaison.—The Sec-
5	retary of Agriculture shall deploy disaster liaisons to State
6	and local Department of Agriculture Service Centers in
7	a federally declared disaster area whenever Federal Emer-
8	gency Management Agency Personnel are deployed in that
9	area, to coordinate Department programs with the appro-
10	priate disaster agencies designated under the Robert T.
11	Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act
12	(42 U.S.C. 5121 et seq.).
13	(b) QUALIFICATIONS.—Disaster liaisons shall be se-
14	lected from among Department employees who have expe-
15	rience providing emergency disaster relief in federally de-
16	clared disaster areas.
17	(c) Duties.—A disaster liaison shall—
18	(1) serve as a liaison to State and Federal
19	Emergency Services;
20	(2) be deployed to a federally declared disaster
21	area to coordinate Department interagency pro-
22	grams in assistance to agricultural producers in the
23	declared disaster area;
24	(3) facilitate the claims and applications of ag-
25	ricultural producers who are victims of the disaster

- that are forwarded to the Department by the appropriate State Department of Agriculture agency director; and

  (4) coordinate with the Director of the State of-
- (4) coordinate with the Director of the State office of the appropriate Department agency to assist with the application for and distribution of economic assistance.
- 8 (d) Duration of Deployment.—The deployment 9 of a disaster liaison under subsection (a) may not exceed 10 30 days.

## 11 SEC. 2. DEFINITION.

- In this Act, the term "federally declared disaster
- 13 area" means—
- 14 (1) an area covered by a Presidential declara-
- tion of major disaster, including a disaster caused by
- a wildfire, issued under section 301 of the Robert T.
- 17 Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance
- 18 Act (42 U.S.C. 5170); or
- 19 (2) determined to be a disaster area, including
- a disaster caused by a wildfire, by the Secretary

- 1 under subpart A of part 1945 of title 7, Code of
- 2 Federal Regulations.
