A BILL

To provide additional funds for deployment rotation and
other relief for United States troops serving in Iraq.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AVAILABILITY OF ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR DE-**
4 **PLOYMENT ROTATION AND OTHER RELIEF**
5 **FOR UNITED STATES TROOPS SERVING IN**
6 **IRAQ.**

7 (a) AVAILABILITY.—Notwithstanding any other pro-
8 vision of law, \$200,000,000 of the amount made available
9 for United States contributions to the United Nations

1 under the heading “International Organizations and Con-
2 ferences—contributions to international organizations”
3 under the Departments of Commerce, Justice, and State,
4 the Judiciary, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act,
5 2004, may be made available to provide adequate deploy-
6 ment rotation and other relief for United States troops
7 serving in Iraq.

8 (b) EXCEPTION.—The requirement of subsection (a)
9 shall not apply if the United Nations adopts a resolution
10 that provides support for the security, rehabilitation, and
11 reconstruction activities of the United States in Iraq and
12 provides appropriate financial and in kind contributions
13 from other member nations of the United Nations in sup-
14 port of such activities.
