To authorize the President to award the Medal of Honor posthumously to Garlin Murl Conner for acts of valor during World War II.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AUTHORITY FOR AWARD OF MEDAL OF HONOR**
4 **TO GARLIN MURL CONNER.**

5 Notwithstanding the time limitations specified in sec-
6 tion 3744(b) of title 10, United States Code, or any other
7 time limitation, the President may award the Medal of
8 Honor posthumously to Garlin Murl Conner of Clinton
9 County, Kentucky, for acts of valor during World War II

1 while serving in the 3d Infantry Division of the United
2 States Army.
