A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT DAIRY FORWARD PRICING PRO-
4 GRAM.**

5 Section 23 of the Agricultural Adjustment Act (7
6 U.S.C. 627), reenacted with amendments by the Agricul-
7 tural Marketing Agreement Act of 1937, is amended—

3 (2) in subsection (a)—

4 (A) in the subsection heading, by striking
5 “PILOT”; and

6 (B) by striking “Not later than” and all
7 that follows through “temporary pilot program”
8 and inserting “The Secretary of Agriculture
9 shall conduct, as a permanent program of the
10 Department of Agriculture, a program”;

11 (3) in subsection (c)—

12 (A) in the subsection heading, by striking
13 “PILOT”; and

14 (B) in paragraph (1), by striking “pilot”;
15 and

16 (4) by striking subsections (d) and (e).
