A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to provide that military retired pay for nonregular service shall be paid without regard to the age of a person otherwise eligible for such retired pay, rather than commencing when an otherwise eligible person attains age 60.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Armed Forces Retire-
5 ment Equity Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. IMMEDIATE RECEIPT OF MILITARY RETIRED PAY**
2 **FOR NONREGULAR SERVICE.**

3 (a) **REPEAL OF RECEIPT AT AGE 60.**—Section
4 12731(a)(1) of title 10, United States Code, is amended—

5 (1) by striking paragraph (1); and

6 (2) by redesignating paragraphs (2) through
7 (4) as paragraphs (1) thru (3), respectively.

8 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
9 subsection (a) shall take effect on the first day of the first
10 month beginning after the date of the enactment of this
11 Act and shall apply with respect to retired pay payable
12 for that month and subsequent months.
