A BILL

To enhance the public safety by rendering aliens ineligible to receive visas and ineligible for admission to the United States if their entry poses a danger to national security, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Inadmissibility of Na-

5 tional Security Aliens Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. INADMISSIBILITY OF PERSONS POSING NATIONAL**2 **SECURITY THREAT.**

3 Section 212(a)(3) of the Immigration and Nationality

4 Act (8 U.S.C. 1182(a)(3)) is amended by adding at the

5 end the following:

6 “(G) NATIONAL SECURITY THREAT.—Any
7 alien whose entry or proposed activities in the
8 United States the Secretary of State or the Sec-
9 retary of Homeland Security, in consultation
10 with appropriate heads of other executive
11 branch agencies, has reason to believe would
12 pose a danger to the national security (as de-
13 fined in section 219(c)(2)) is inadmissible.”.
