3 **SECTION 1. JOHN LEWIS CIVIL RIGHTS INSTITUTE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The building located at 493 Au-
5 burn Avenue, N.E., in Atlanta, Georgia, shall be known
6 and designated as the “John Lewis Civil Rights Insti-
7 tute”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
10 States to the building referred to in subsection (a) shall
