A BILL

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. REQUIREMENT RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION

DRUG BENEFITS FOR MEDICARE-ELIGIBLE

ENROLLEES UNDER DEFENSE HEALTH CARE

PLANS.

Section 1074g(a)(6) of title 10, United States Code,

is amended—

1	(1) by inserting " (A) " after " (6) "; and
2	(2) by adding at the end the following:
3	"(B) For a medicare-eligible beneficiary, the
4	cost-sharing requirements may not be in excess of
5	the cost-sharing requirements applicable to all other
6	beneficiaries covered by section 1086 of this title.
7	For purposes of the preceding sentence, a medicare-
8	eligible beneficiary is a beneficiary eligible for health
9	benefits under section 1086 of this title pursuant to
10	subsection $(d)(2)$ of such section.".
