A BILL

To clarify the lands over which Indian tribes shall have jurisdiction or exercise governmental power.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. JURISDICTION OF INDIAN TRIBES OVER LAND.
- 4 (a) Tribes With Lands.—No Indian tribe shall
- 5 have jurisdiction over, or shall exercise governmental
- 6 power within, any land that is not located in the same
- 7 State as the reservation, trust lands, or other tribal lands
- 8 that constituted the principal residence and location of
- 9 that Indian tribe on the date of the enactment of this sec-
- 10 tion, unless such land is—

1	(1) contiguous to the lands that constituted the
2	principal residence and location of the Indian tribe
3	as of the date of the enactment of this section; or
4	(2) has been taken into trust in accordance
5	with section 5 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (25
6	U.S.C. 465).
7	(b) Tribes With No Lands.—An Indian tribe that
8	had no reservation, trust lands, or other tribal lands on
9	the date of the enactment of this section shall not have
10	jurisdiction over, or exercise governmental power within,
11	any land located outside of the State in which that Indian
12	tribe was principally located as of the date of the enact-
13	ment of this section, until and unless land has been taken
14	into trust on behalf of that Indian tribe in accordance with
15	section 5 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (25 U.S.C. 465).
16	(c) Applicability.—This section shall apply to
17	lands owned by an Indian tribe on the date of the enact-
18	ment of this section or acquired by an Indian tribe after
19	the date of the enactment of this section.
