3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF BENEFITS.**

4 (a) FOREIGN AIR CARRIER DEFINED.—Section
5 4002(a) of the Emergency Wartime Supplemental Appro-

1 priations Act, 2003 (Public Law 108–11; 26 U.S.C. 3304
2 note) is amended—

3 (1) in paragraph (6), by striking “and”;

4 (2) in paragraph (7), by striking the period and
5 inserting “; and”; and

6 (3) by adding at the end the following:

7 “(8) the term ‘foreign air carrier’ has the
8 meaning given such term under section 40102 of
9 title 49, United States Code.”.

10 (b) EXTENSION OF BENEFITS.—Section 4002(a)(2)
11 of the Emergency Wartime Supplemental Appropriations
12 Act, 2003 is amended by inserting “or foreign air carrier”
13 after “air carrier” each place it appears.

14 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

15 The amendments made by this Act shall take effect
16 as if included in the enactment of the Emergency Wartime
17 Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2003.
