- 5 **PEOPLE.**
- 6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, amounts
- 7 available for assistance for the Palestinian Authority (or

- 1 any other Palestinian entity) or for the Palestinian people
- 2 may not be obligated or expended until the perpetrators,
- 3 or suspected perpetrators, of the killings of United States
- 4 citizens in Gaza on October 15, 2003, are surrendered to
