- 7 Section 403(1) of the Missing Children's Assistance
- 8 Act (42 U.S.C. 5772(1)) is amended by inserting "(or
- 9 whose mental capacity is less than 18 years of age as de-

- 1 termined by an appropriate medical authority)" after
- 2 "age".
- 3 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 4 This Act and the amendment made by this Act shall
- 5 take effect on the 1st day of the 1st fiscal year beginning
- 6 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
