## A BILL

To amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act to authorize the use of funds made available for nonpoint source management programs for projects and activities relating to the development and implementation of phase II of the storm water program of the Environmental Protection Agency.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Storm Water Abate-  
5       ment Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PHASE II STORM WATER PROGRAM IMPLEMENTA-**  
2 **TION AND MANAGEMENT.**

3 Section 319(h) of the Federal Water Pollution Con-  
4 trol Act (33 U.S.C. 1329(h)) is amended by adding at the  
5 end the following:

6 “(13) PHASE II STORM WATER IMPLEMENTA-  
7 TION.—A State may use funds from a grant pro-  
8 vided under this subsection—

9 “(A) to carry out a project or activity re-  
10 lating to the development or implementation of  
11 phase II of the storm water program of the En-  
12 vironmental Protection Agency established by  
13 the final rule entitled ‘National Pollutant Dis-  
14 charge Elimination System—Regulations for  
15 Revision of the Water Pollution Control Pro-  
16 gram Addressing Storm Water Discharges’,  
17 promulgated by the Administrator on December  
18 8, 1999 (64 Fed. Reg. 68722); and

19 “(B) to implement a management program  
20 in a geographic jurisdiction for phase II of the  
21 program described in subparagraph (A).”.
