## SECTION 1. COMPLETION OF CERTAIN COURSES FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION.

3 Section 5111 of the Elementary and Secondary Edu4 cation Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7211) is amended by add5 ing at the end the following:

6 "(c) LIMITATION.—No State educational agency or 7 outlying area shall be eligible to receive funds under this 8 section unless the State or area requires all students who 9 graduate from a public secondary school with a regular 10 diploma in the standard number of years or fewer to have 11 successfully completed secondary school courses in Amer-12 ican history and American government.".
