A BILL

To authorize the Secretary of Defense to reimburse members of the Armed Forces for the cost of protective body armor purchased by or on behalf of the member.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REIMBURSEMENT OF MEMBERS OF THE
- 4 ARMED FORCES FOR PURCHASE OF PROTEC-
- 5 TIVE BODY ARMOR.
- 6 (a) Reimbursement Authorized.—The Secretary
- 7 of Defense may reimburse a member of the Armed Forces
- 8 for the cost of protective body armor purchased by the
- 9 member, or by another person on behalf of the member,

- 1 for use by the member while deployed in connection with
- 2 Operation Noble Eagle, Operation Enduring Freedom, or
- 3 Operation Iraqi Freedom if the member was so deployed
- 4 and was not issued protective body armor before such de-
- 5 ployment.
- 6 (b) Duration of Authority.—Reimbursement
- 7 may be provided under subsection (a) for protective body
- 8 armor purchased during the period beginning on Sep-
- 9 tember 11, 2001, and ending on December 31, 2003. Not
- 10 later than 60 days after the date of the enactment of this
- 11 Act, the Secretary shall implement regulations to expedite
- 12 the provision of such reimbursement.
