- 3 SECTION 1. ANNUAL REPORT ON ERADICATION OF POPPY
- 4 CULTIVATION AND ILLICIT DRUG TRAF-
- 5 FICKING IN AFGHANISTAN.
- 6 (a) Annual Report.—Not later than 60 days after
- 7 the date of the enactment of this Act, and annually there-
- 8 after, the Secretary of State shall prepare and submit to
- 9 the appropriate congressional committees a report that

- 1 contains a detailed description on progress made during
- 2 the prior year to eradicate poppy cultivation and prevent
- 3 illicit drug trafficking in Afghanistan.
- 4 (b) Definition.—In this section, the term "appro-
- 5 priate congressional committees" means—
- 6 (1) the Committee on International Relations
- 7 and the Committee on Appropriations of the House
- 8 of Representatives; and
- 9 (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and

the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate.
