A BILL

To require the Secretary of State to prepare an annual report on progress made to eradicate poppy cultivation and prevent illicit drug trafficking in Afghanistan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ANNUAL REPORT ON ERADICATION OF POPPY**
4 **CULTIVATION AND ILLICIT DRUG TRAF-**
5 **FICKING IN AFGHANISTAN.**

6 (a) ANNUAL REPORT.—Not later than 60 days after
7 the date of the enactment of this Act, and annually there-
8 after, the Secretary of State shall prepare and submit to
9 the appropriate congressional committees a report that

1 contains a detailed description on progress made during
2 the prior year to eradicate poppy cultivation and prevent
3 illicit drug trafficking in Afghanistan.

4 (b) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “appro-
5 priate congressional committees” means—

6 (1) the Committee on International Relations
7 and the Committee on Appropriations of the House
8 of Representatives; and

9 (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and
10 the Committee on Appropriations of the Senate.
