1	SECTION 1. AUTHORITY TO ENTER INTO NEGOTIATIONS ON

3	MEDICARE BENEFICIARIES.
4	Section 1860D-11(i) of the Social Security Act, as
5	added by section 101(a) of the Medicare Prescription
6	Drug, Improvement, and Modernization Act of 2003, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	"(i) DIRECT NEGOTIATIONS.—In order to promote
9	the best price of prescription drugs for part D eligible
10	beneficiaries and in carrying out this part, the Secretary
11	may enter into direct negotiations between—
12	"(1) drug manufacturers and pharmacies; and
13	"(2) PDP sponsors and MA organizations of-
14	fering MA-PD plans.".
