A BILL

To prohibit the Office of Federal Detention Trustee from constructing Federal detention centers and to prohibit the Department of Justice from siting a detention center or Federal prison in Maryland, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON THE SITING OF CERTAIN DE-**
4 **TENTION CENTERS AND PRISONS.**

5 (a) FEDERAL DETENTION CENTERS.—The Office of
6 Federal Detention Trustee in the Department of Justice
7 may not expend any funds for the construction of, or the

1 solicitation of construction proposals for, any Federal de-
2 tention center.

3 (b) CENTERS AND PRISONS IN MARYLAND.—The At-
4 torney General of the United States is prohibited from
5 constructing or acquiring any property or facilities in the
6 State of Maryland to be used as a detention center or Fed-
7 eral prison.
