- 2 RELATED CREDIT CARD AND OTHER FRAUD.
- 3 In addition to any other sums authorized to be appro-
- 4 priated for this purpose, there is authorized to be appro-
- 5 priated to the Department of Justice, \$100,000,000 for
- 6 the investigation and prosecution of identity theft and re-
- 7 lated credit card and other fraud cases.
