## A BILL

For the relief of Benjamin Cabrera and Londy Patricia Cabrera.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR BEN-4 JAMIN CABRERA AND LONDY PATRICIA 5 CABRERA. 6 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Benjamin Cabrera and Londy Patricia Cabrera shall 8 each be eligible for issuance of an immigrant visa or for 10 adjustment of status to that of an alien lawfully admitted

for permanent residence upon filing an application for

- 1 issuance of an immigrant visa under section 204 of such
- 2 Act or for adjustment of status to lawful permanent resi-
- 3 dent.
- 4 (b) Adjustment of Status.—If Benjamin Cabrera
- 5 or Londy Patricia Cabrera enters the United States before
- 6 the filing deadline specified in subsection (c), he or she
- 7 shall be considered to have entered and remained lawfully
- 8 and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligible for adjustment
- 9 of status under section 245 of the Immigration and Na-
- 10 tionality Act as of the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 11 (c) Deadline for Application and Payment of
- 12 Fees.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
- 13 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
- 14 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
- 15 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 16 (d) Reduction of Immigrant Visa Number.—
- 17 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent res-
- 18 idence to Benjamin Cabrera and Londy Patricia Cabrera,
- 19 the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper officer to
- 20 reduce by 2, during the current or next following fiscal
- 21 year, the total number of immigrant visas that are made
- 22 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth
- 23 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
- 24 Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas

- 1 that are made available to natives of the country of the
- 2 aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act.
