### A BILL

To authorize the grant program under which the Secretary of Homeland Security makes discretionary grants for use in high-threat, high-density urban areas, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as "Targeting Homeland Secu-
- 5 rity Resources Effectively Against Terrorism Act of 2004"
- 6 or the "THREAT Act".

# 1 SEC. 2. PROGRAM OF GRANTS FOR USE IN HIGH-THREAT, 2 HIGH-DENSITY URBAN AREAS.

- 3 (a) Grant Program.—From amounts made avail-
- 4 able to the Secretary of Homeland Security for discre-
- 5 tionary grants for use in high-threat, high-density urban
- 6 areas, the Secretary shall carry out a program under
- 7 which the Secretary makes such grants in accordance with
- 8 this section.
- 9 (b) Maximum Number of Grantees.—For any fis-
- 10 cal year, the Secretary may award such grants to not more
- 11 than 15 such areas.
- (c) Factors Considered.—In determining wheth-
- 13 er, and in what allocation, to award such a grant to such
- 14 an area, the Secretary shall consider the following three
- 15 factors:
- 16 (1) The population of that urban area.
- 17 (2) The presence of critical infrastructure in
- that urban area.
- 19 (3) The credibility of the threat to that urban
- area.
- 21 (d) Weight of Factors.—In considering the fac-
- 22 tors required by subsection (c), the Secretary shall give
- 23 the factor described in subsection (c)(2) two times the
- 24 weight given the factor described in subsection (c)(1), and
- 25 shall give the factor described in subsection (c)(3) three

- 1 times the weight given the factor described in subsection
- 2 (c)(1).
- 3 (e) Definition of Factors.—The Secretary shall,
- 4 for purposes of this section, define the factors required
- 5 by subsection (c). In defining the factor described in sub-
- 6 section (c)(1), the Secretary shall ensure that tourists and
- 7 commuters are considered as part of the population.
- 8 (f) Disbursement Directly to Localities.—All
- 9 amounts awarded to an area under this section shall be
- 10 disbursed directly to one or more local governments within
- 11 the area.
