## A BILL

To amend title 49, United States Code, to allow additional transit systems greater flexibility with certain mass transportation projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Transit System Flexi-  
5 bility Protection Act of 2004”.

6 **SEC. 2. GENERAL AUTHORITY.**

7 Section 5307(b)(1) of title 49, United States Code,  
8 is amended by adding at the end the following: “The Sec-  
9 retary may make grants under this section to a transit

1 system to finance the operating cost of equipment and fa-  
2 cilities for use in mass transportation in an urbanized area  
3 with a population of more than 200,000 if such transit  
4 system operates less than 100 buses on fixed route service  
5 during peak service hours.”.
