 3 SECTION 1. BAN ON IMPORTATION OF SOYBEANS AND SOY4 BEAN MEAL THAT ARE PRODUCTS OF ARGEN5 TINA OR BRAZIL.
 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—No person may import into the
- 7 customs territory of the United States soybeans provided
- 8 for in heading 1201.00.00 of the Harmonized Tariff
- 9 Schedule of the United States, or soybean meal provided

- 1 for in subheading 1208.10.00 of such Schedule, that is
- 2 the product of Argentina or Brazil.
- 3 (b) Construction.—For purposes of subsection (a),
- 4 the term "import" includes withdrawal from warehouse

5 for consumption.
