## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to extend the replacement period from 2 to 5 years for livestock sold on account of drought, flood, or other weather-related conditions.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF REPLACEMENT PERIOD FOR**

4       **LIVESTOCK SOLD ON ACCOUNT OF DROUGHT,**

5       **FLOOD, OR OTHER WEATHER-RELATED CON-**

6       **DITIONS.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (e) of section 1033 of

8       the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to livestock

1 sold on account of drought, flood, or other weather-related  
2 conditions) is amended by adding at the end the following:  
3 “In the case of any involuntary conversion described in  
4 the preceding sentence, subsection (a)(2)(B) shall be ap-  
5 plied by substituting ‘5 years’ for ‘2 years’ in clause (i)  
6 thereof.”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
8 subsection (a) shall apply to sales and exchanges of live-  
9 stock after December 31, 2000.
