3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF SUNSET ON ASSAULT WEAPONS**

4 **BAN FOR 10 YEARS.**

5 Section 110105(2) of the Violent Crime Control and
6 Law Enforcement Act of 1994 (18 U.S.C. 921 note) is
7 amended by inserting “, or in the case of the amendments
8 made by section 110102, 20 years,” after “10 years”.
