- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1860C–1(b) of the Social
- 7 Security Act, as added by section 241 of the Medicare Pre-
- 8 scription Drug, Improvement, and Modernization Act of

- 1 2003 (Public Law 108–173), is amended by adding at the
- 2 end the following:
- 3 "(3) NO CCA AREAS WITHIN NEW MEXICO.—A
- 4 CCA area shall not include an MSA any portion of
- 5 which is within the State of New Mexico.".
- 6 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 7 this section shall take effect as if included in the enact-
- 8 ment of the Medicare Prescription Drug, Improvement,
- 9 and Modernization Act of 2003.
