A BILL

- To amend the National Trails System Act to clarify Federal authority relating to land acquisition from willing sellers for the majority of the trails in the System, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as "National Trails System5 Willing Seller Act".

1SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE LANDS FROM WILLING2SELLERS FOR CERTAIN TRAILS.

3 (a) OREGON NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL.—Section 5(a)(3) of the National Trails System Act (16 U.S.C. 4 5 1244(a)(3)) is amended by adding at the end the following: "No lands or interests therein outside the exterior 6 7 boundaries of any federally administered area may be ac-8 quired by the Federal Government for the trail except with 9 the consent of the owner thereof. The authority of the 10 Federal Government to acquire fee title under this para-11 graph shall be limited to an average of not more than onequarter mile on either side of the trail.". 12

13 (b) Mormon PIONEER NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL.—Section 5(a)(4) of the National Trails System 14 Act (16 U.S.C. 1244(a)(4)) is amended by adding at the 15 16 end the following: "No lands or interests therein outside the exterior boundaries of any federally administered area 17 may be acquired by the Federal Government for the trail 18 19 except with the consent of the owner thereof. The author-20 ity of the Federal Government to acquire fee title under this paragraph shall be limited to an average of not more 21 22 than one-quarter mile on either side of the trail.".

23 (c) CONTINENTAL DIVIDE NATIONAL SCENIC
24 TRAIL.—Section 5(a)(5) of the National Trails System
25 Act (16 U.S.C. 1244(a)(5)) is amended by adding at the
26 end the following: "No lands or interests therein outside

the exterior boundaries of any federally administered area
 may be acquired by the Federal Government for the trail
 except with the consent of the owner thereof. The author ity of the Federal Government to acquire fee title under
 this paragraph shall be limited to an average of not more
 than one-quarter mile on either side of the trail.".

7 (d) CLARK NATIONAL HISTORIC LEWIS AND 8 TRAIL.—Section 5(a)(6) of the National Trails System 9 Act (16 U.S.C. 1244(a)(6)) is amended by adding at the 10 end the following: "No lands or interests therein outside the exterior boundaries of any federally administered area 11 may be acquired by the Federal Government for the trail 12 13 except with the consent of the owner thereof. The authority of the Federal Government to acquire fee title under 14 15 this paragraph shall be limited to an average of not more than one-quarter mile on either side of the trail.". 16

17 (e) IDITAROD NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL.—Section 5(a)(7) of the National Trails System Act (16 U.S.C. 18 19 1244(a)(7)) is amended by adding at the end the following: "No lands or interests therein outside the exterior 2021 boundaries of any federally administered area may be ac-22 quired by the Federal Government for the trail except with 23 the consent of the owner thereof. The authority of the 24 Federal Government to acquire fee title under this para1 graph shall be limited to an average of not more than one-2 quarter mile on either side of the trail.".

(f) NORTH COUNTRY NATIONAL SCENIC TRAIL.—
Section 5(a)(8) of the National Trails System Act (16
U.S.C. 1244(a)(8)) is amended by adding at the end the
following: "No lands or interests therein outside the exterior boundaries of any federally administered area may be
acquired by the Federal Government for the trail except
with the consent of the owner thereof.".

10 (g) ICE AGE NATIONAL SCENIC TRAIL.—Section 11 5(a)(10) of the National Trails System Act (16 U.S.C. 12 1244(a)(10)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-13 lowing: "No lands or interests therein outside the exterior 14 boundaries of any federally administered area may be ac-15 quired by the Federal Government for the trail except with 16 the consent of the owner thereof.".

17 (h) POTOMAC HERITAGE NATIONAL SCENIC TRAIL.—Section 5(a)(11) of the National Trails System 18 Act (16 U.S.C. 1244(a)(11)) is amended by adding at the 19 end the following: "No lands or interests therein outside 20 21 the exterior boundaries of any federally administered area 22 may be acquired by the Federal Government for the trail 23 except with the consent of the owner thereof.".

(i) NEZ PERCE NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL.—Sec25 tion 5(a)(14) of the National Trails System Act (16)

U.S.C. 1244(a)(14) is amended by adding at the end the 1 following: "No lands or interests therein outside the exte-2 3 rior boundaries of any federally administered area may be 4 acquired by the Federal Government for the trail except 5 with the consent of the owner thereof. The authority of the Federal Government to acquire fee title under this 6 7 paragraph shall be limited to an average of not more than 8 one-quarter mile on either side of the trail.".

9 (j) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 10(c) of the
10 National Trails System Act (16 U.S.C. 1249(c)) is amend11 ed to read as follows:

"(c)(1) Except as otherwise provided in this Act,
there is authorized to be appropriated such sums as may
be necessary to implement the provisions of this Act relating to the trails designated by section 5(a).

16 "(2) Not more than \$500,000 may be appropriated 17 for the purposes of land acquisition and interests therein for the Natchez Trace National Scenic Trail designated 18 by section 5(a)(12) of this Act, and not more than 19 20 \$2,000,000 may be appropriated for the purposes of the 21 development of such trail. The administering agency for 22 the trail shall encourage volunteer trail groups to participate in the development of the trail.". 23
